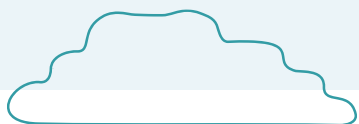


Hesitations about switching veterinary software

In fact, the entire process for upgrading your veterinary software can be performed quickly, efficiently, and economically—and allow you to stay you.

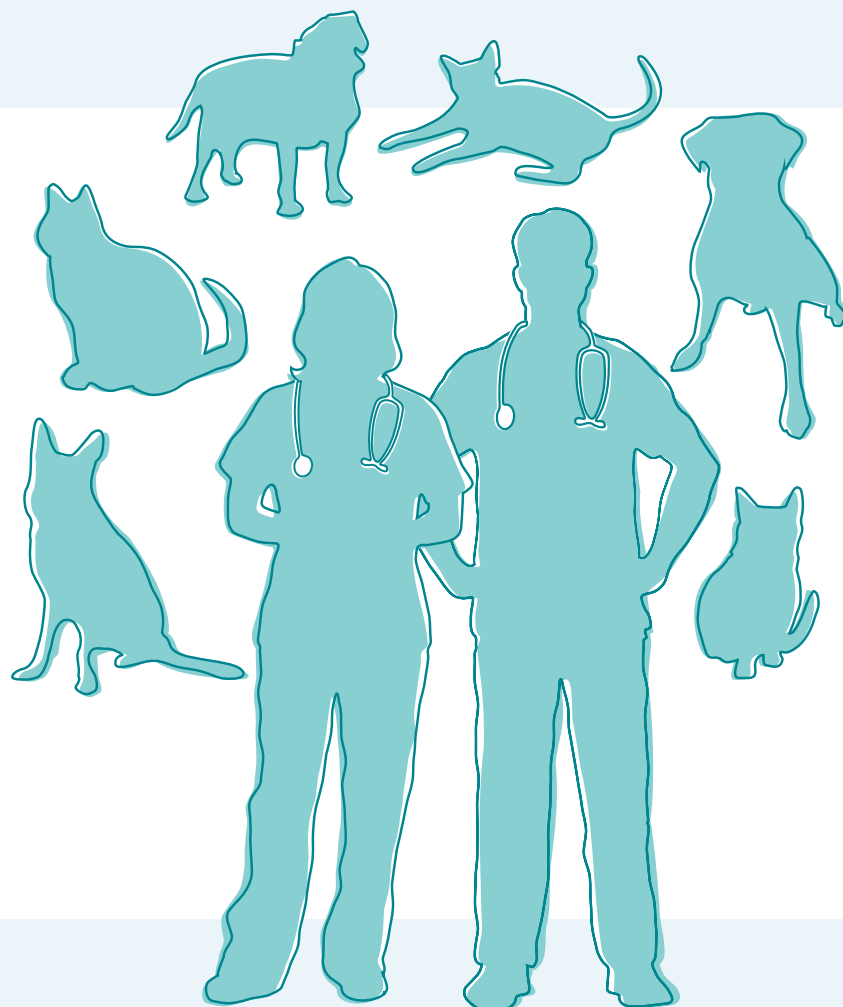


Change is natural

Data loss

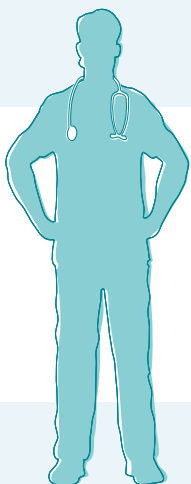
